

Envac Korea is awarded Gwang Myung project totalling € 10 million.

The 10MEUR -worth project awarded by the 4 Reconstruction Unions to Envac Korea is intended for installation of an underground waste transport system in a new residential area in the city of Gwang Myung, in the Seoul region. The system will handle the waste from 7399 apartments, equalling 13 tons per day. The project is to commence immediately and will be completed December 31st 2009. On completion the residents will have access to a 2 fraction (food waste & rest) Envac underground waste transport system.

"This is a key order for our Asian region and for Envac as a whole." says Christer Öjdemark, President & CEO of Envac. "We expect the Korean market to develop very favourably in the next few years", adds Christer Öjdemark.
