Historically, contract work is the first type of employment to rebound after a recession. Beyond the expected cyclical increase in contract workers, the flexible workforce approach is becoming an established hiring model to get more done with less, scale to meet demand and increase business efficiency. The broad accessibility afforded by the Internet, the post-recession economy, and the interest in globalization are driving adoption of a on-demand contract workforce.
