Issue Defined

Existing health care delivery systems are fragmented, which creates unnecessary costs and complications for people with complex needs and chronic conditions. Current models of care lack a patient-centric focus, fail to allocate resources to support preventive health services and do not provide for properly aligned incentives to influence clinical, administrative and financial outcomes in a positive manner.

Background

In the search for higher quality, more affordable health care, the Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH) rapidly has gained momentum. The PCMH model of care strengthens the clinician-patient relationship by replacing episodic care with coordinated care and a long-term relationship. Each patient has a relationship with a Primary Care Provider (PCP) who is held accountable for patient care and outcomes. The PCP leads a team in providing for the patient's health care needs and arranging for appropriate care with other qualified clinicians. The goal of the medical home model is to provide more personalized, coordinated, effective and efficient care.
