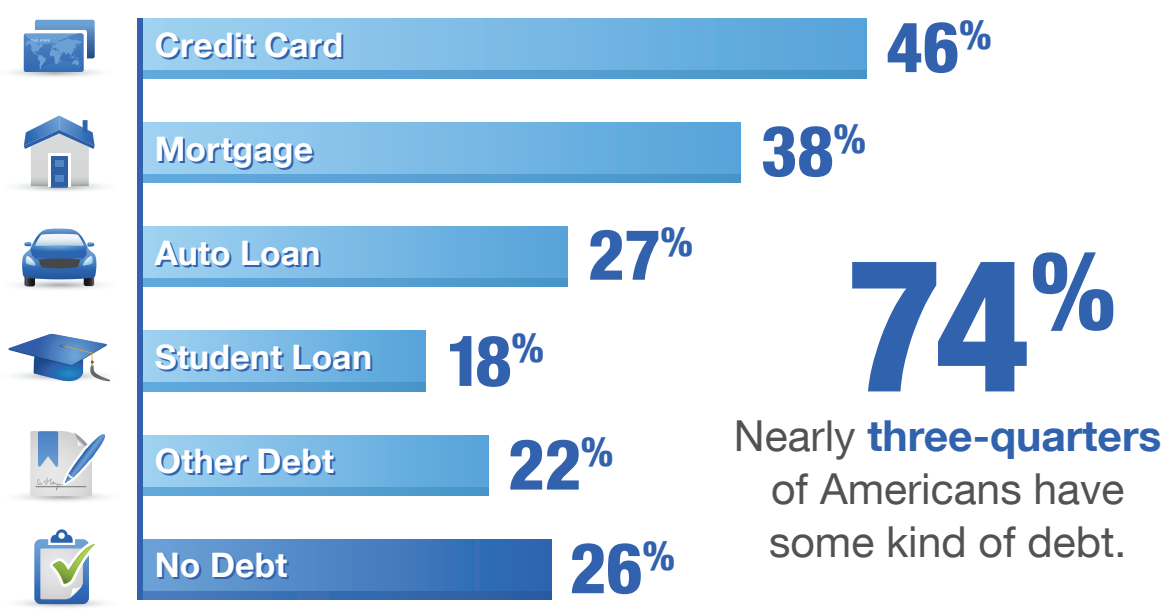




Financial Health vs Physical Health

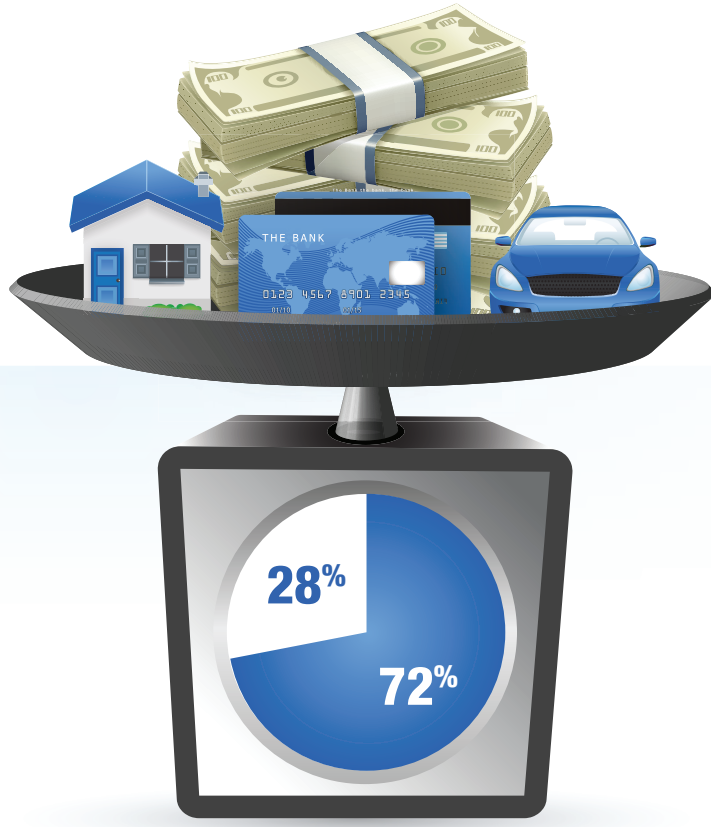
With bathing suit season in full swing, we teamed up with **Harris Interactive** to examine Americans' attitudes about their physical appearance and health compared to their finances.

Types of Debt

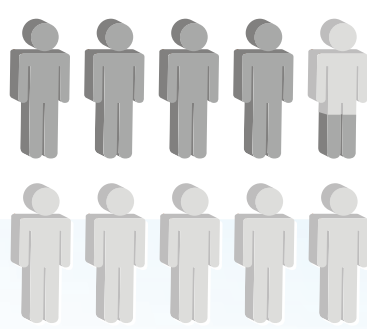


72%

of Americans would rather **keep their current debt** than gain 25 pounds and be completely debt free.

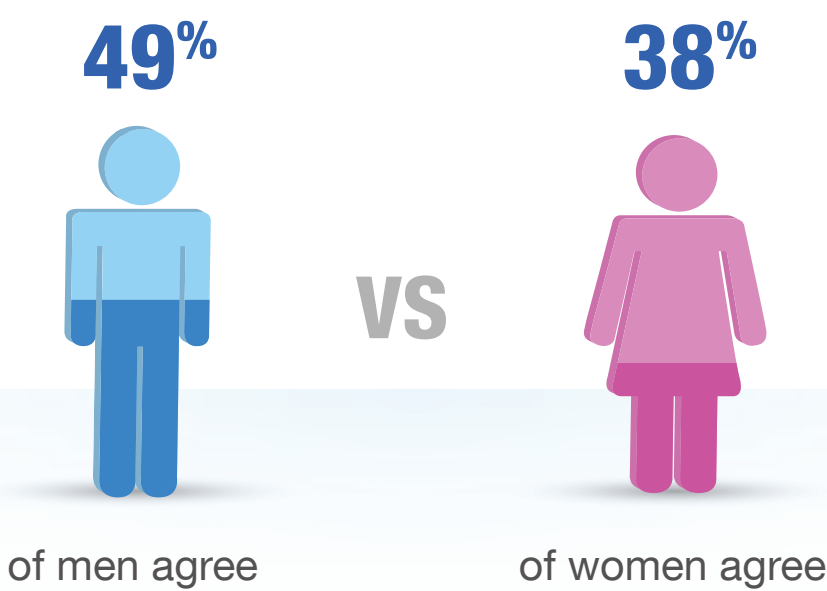


“How much I **weigh** is more important than how much **debt** I have.”
