

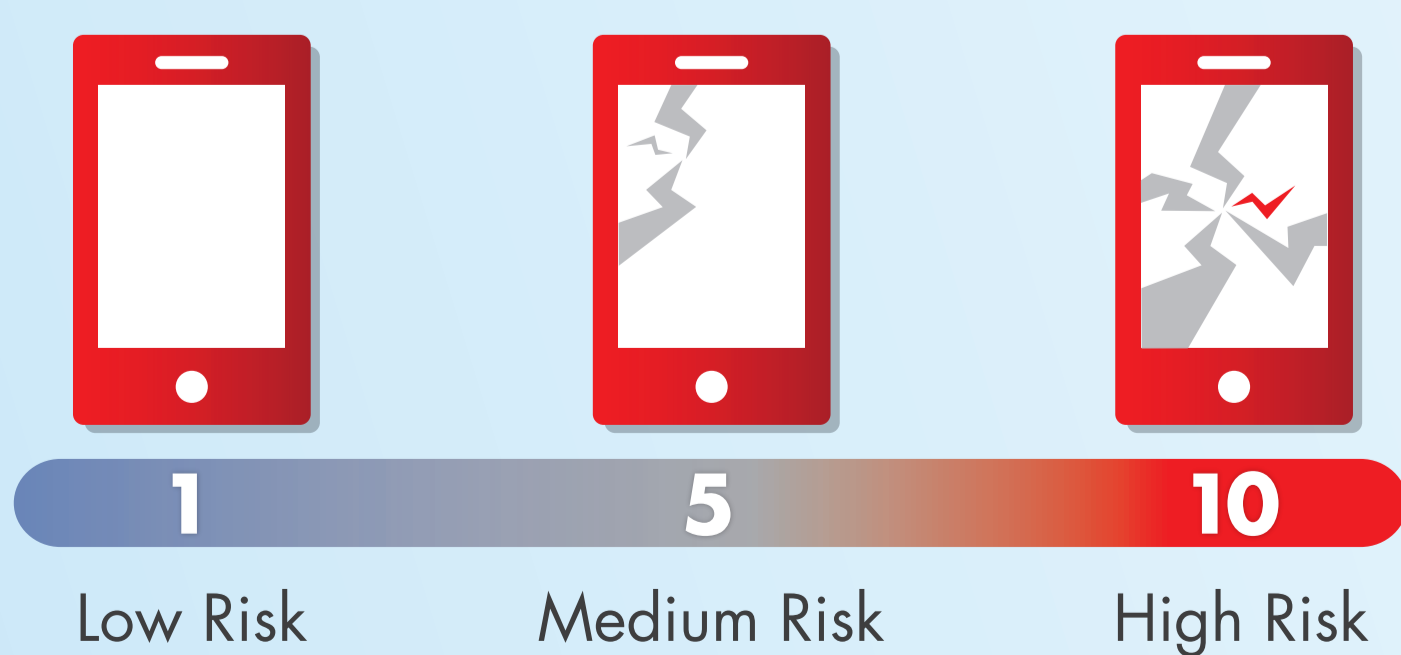
iPHONE 6 AND 6 PLUS: IS BIGGER BETTER?

The iPhone 6 Plus also did extremely well, but is so big that it lost points for grip-ability and size and didn't do quite as well in our drop test. So, is bigger really better? Yes, although the biggest isn't always the best.

HOW WE CALCULATE THE SQUARETRADE BREAKABILITY SCORE
