AUSTIN (KXAN) - When LiveStrong moved its headquarters from an unidentified office building in Central Austin to East Sixth Street in 2009, the organization always planned to have a place people could come for help living with cancer.

On Friday, the [LiveStrong Cancer Navigation Center](#) officially opened its doors on the same piece of property. The community-based center offers free, one-on-one support for anyone affected by cancer. Since November, counselors have been on hand assisting the public. Before, the help was only available by phone or online.


The center offers emotional support, information on fertility risks that come with cancer treatments, guidance on options to help pay for treatment and general information about treatment.

A grand opening celebration is scheduled from 3:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Friday at the center at 2201 E. Sixth St., Austin, 78702.

Lance Armstrong, LiveStrong's founder, is expected to speak at 5 p.m.
